The following alterations would affect more than marginally and insignificantly the appearance or the historical, architectural, archaeological and cultural qualities of the Property and will require prior review and approval from the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). All requests for approval must be in writing and sent by way of either email or regular mail. *This list is meant to be a guide and by no means is exhaustive; please contact the SHPO with any questions.*

Replacements

- Windows and doors
- Roofing material
- Siding
- Structural framing members
- Foundations

Alterations

- Painting
- New window and door openings
- All items requiring a local building permit (porches, decks, additions, etc.)
- Masonry repairs and repointing

The following actions do not require prior SHPO review and approval:

- General landscaping and lawn care not involving the removal of soils or site grading
- Replacing broken window panes, in kind
- Cleaning gutters and downspouts
- Removing moss and other lichen growth from wood and masonry features
- Weather-stripping doors and windows
- Re-caulking around areas where windows and doors meet the siding
